District's Accomplishments and Goals:

- Appointed unit reps at all units in district 5 to communicate info down to the Soldiers.
 - Directly improved communication within the district
 - Established frequent meetings with unit reps to keep them informed of all updates, to incorporate accountability and to discuss statuses of current memberships
 - Improved information flow of nation and local updates, membership goals and legislative efforts
- Established Enlisted information booths at PHA sites: increased membership and awareness
 - communicate EANGUS awareness as a benefit brief
 - Addressed overall issue of awareness by utilizing the MEDCOM mission of directly talking to "Every Soldier, Every Year"
 - Key factor: Continue to bring membership awareness to grades E1-E5
 - Continue to implement and utilize the text messaging program to send out association information to members and potential members from leads established during visits to the booth
- Created and executed a plan in which officers pay the membership dues of Soldiers who are grades E-1 through E-5
- Established annual fundraisers that sponsored junior enlisted Soldiers registration and lodging for state conference attendance.

Membership Drive Efforts:

- Continued to ask the women's auxiliary, retirees and family readiness groups to become involved with efforts of the Enlisted information booths.
- Continued to build relationships with retirees to increase membership
- Sought cooperate sponsorships to help pay for memberships of junior enlisted Soldiers

National Efforts:

- Served on the 2015 EANGUS Ways and Means committee to help bid for the 2020 National Conference; to be held in Little Rock
- Served on the 2015 EANGUS committee to discuss the move of the Enlisted Association from Virginia to Washington, D.C.; to be housed in the National museum alongside the National Officers' Association
