NATIONAL GUARD LICENSE PLATE INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

Your plate is issued YEARLY. Registration is from JANUARY 1 through DECEMBER 31 of every year, it doesn't change, no matter when you receive your plate.

Each year, around the 2nd week in October, you can RENEW your plate by calling me or coming by my office or going to your local Revenue Office. <u>PROPERTY TAXES and ASSESSMENT</u> must be completed before you can renew your plate.

PROMOTION

If you are promoted at any time during the year, you can replace your plate with a lower number. You are not required to do this, but the majority of plate holders do. You must call me or stop by my office to do this. Your old plate must be turned in at this time.

LOST or STOLEN PLATES

If your plate is lost or stolen, please call me or come by my office so that the plate can be deactivated and you receive a new plate.

TRANSFERRING PLATES

You may transfer your plate to a new vehicle. However, this must be done at your local Revenue Office. I am not allowed to transfer plates from one vehicle or another.

GETTING OUT OF THE GUARD

If for ANY reason you get out of the GUARD you are required to TURN IN your plate NO LATER THAN 20 days PRIOR to the date you are being discharged. If you do not turn in your plate, your plate WILL BE DEACTIVATED, and you will have to turn in the plate and have the block taken off from this office before any other plate can be issued.
